2. Are scholarships available?

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6. Will transportation be provided for the business trips?

Yes, transportation will be provided for the NYC and Capital Region business trips. We will not provide transportation to and from the class locations.

7. Do I have to be in high school or college?

No. This program is for all rising fashion professionals.

8. Is a payment plan available?

Yes, you can make weekly or monthly payments until the first day of class. All payments must be paid in full by the first day of class.

9. What happens if I am late or miss class?

If you miss more than two classes, you will be disqualified from participating in certain exclusive opportunities. If you are late twice it counts as one absence.

This program is designed to make certain everyone is learning together and supporting each other with their learning process. Therefore, our commitment to all students is to start and end on time to respect your schedules outside of the Institute. Late arrivals and absences disrupts the opportunity to build supportive, meaningful professional relationships and demonstrates to potential employers or apprenticeship sites that you are unreliable!
